


Saturday, Sept 19th USS Hornet. Alameda, 10:30 AM

Following a brief orientation, visitors are free to explore the many passageways, compartments, and decks of this famous ship.

- See historic aircraft and exhibits of WWII. Vietnam, and the Apollo moon missions.
- Walk through Officers' Country, Crew's Berthing, Medical Spaces, Pilot Ready Rooms, and other spaces as you imagine what life was like on a floating city.
- Sense the drama of carrier landings as you peer from the towering captain's bridge.
