- Sense the drama of carrier landings as you peer from the towering captain's bridge.

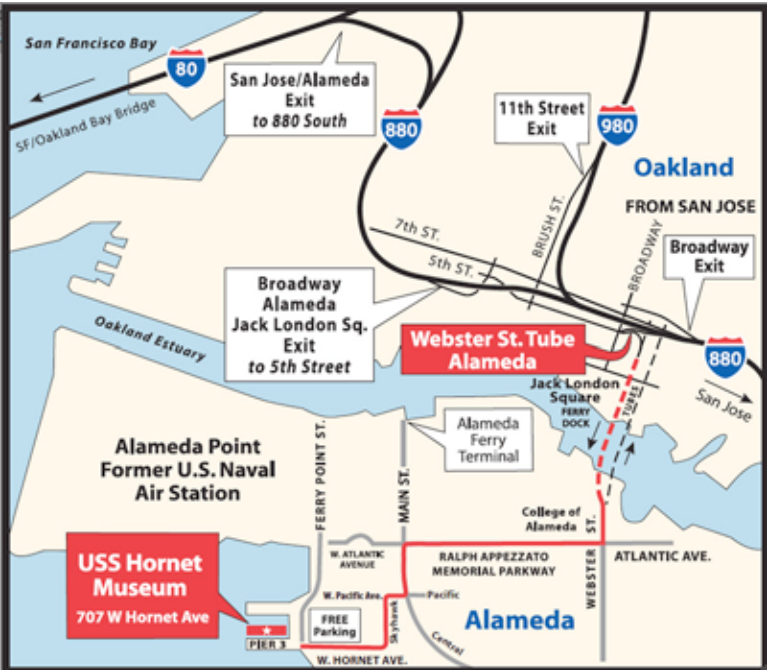
